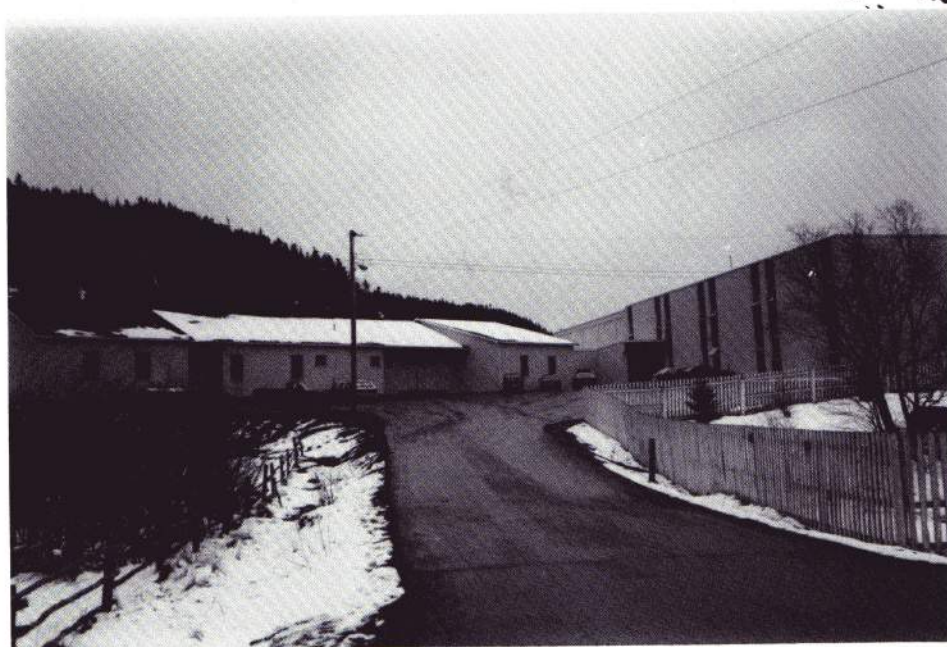

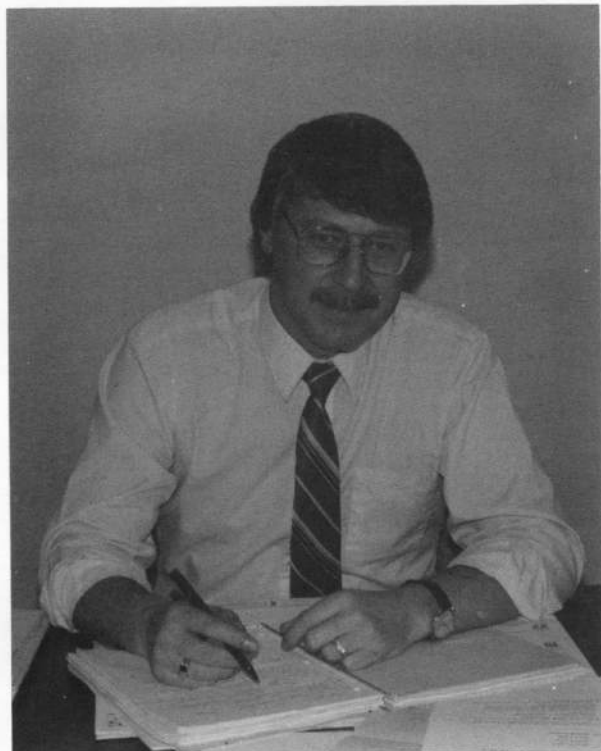

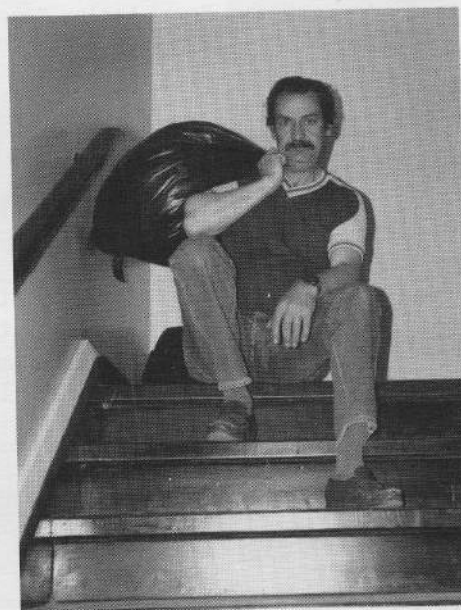

Editor's Message

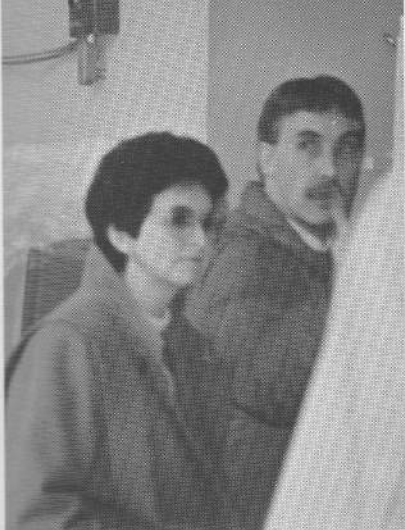

Good luck to the Yearbook Staff of 90-91, hopefully your book will be even better.

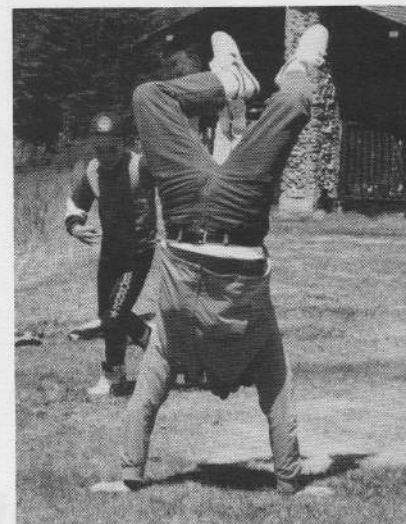
