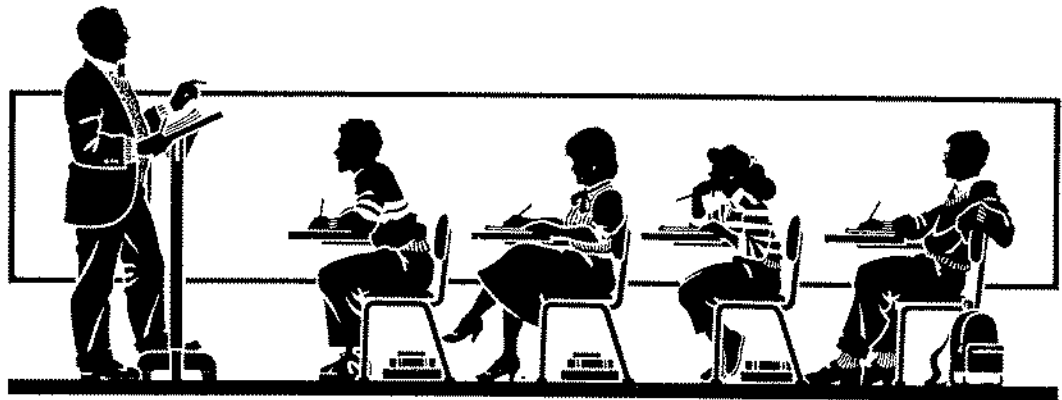
Dedication
