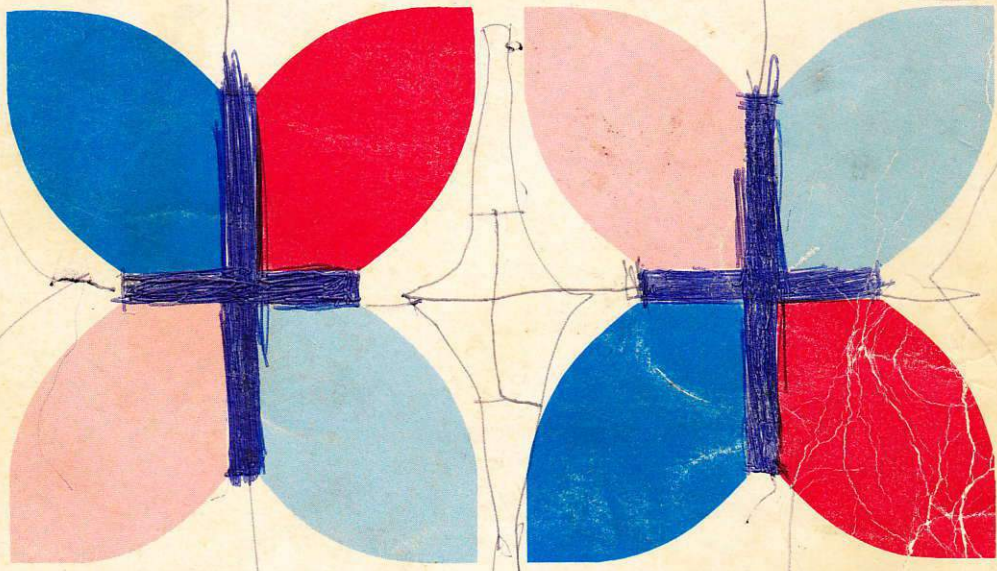
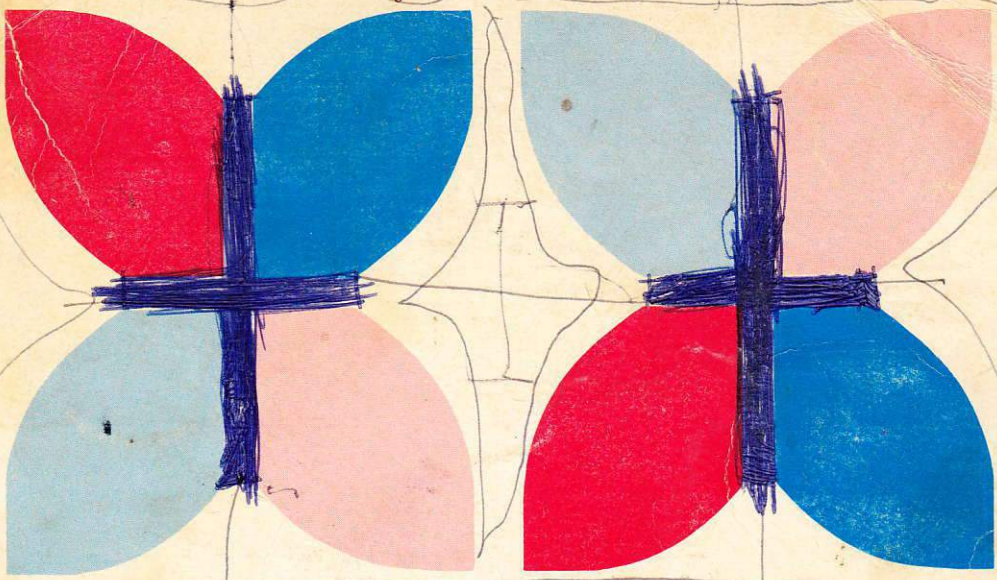

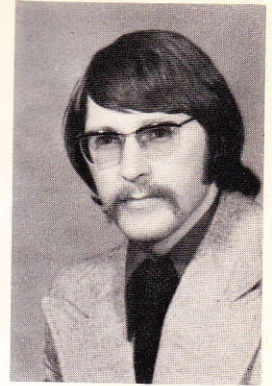

To the grade eleven class, I wish every success and happiness in the future. I would like to leave these words to the undergraduates; "Hard work is the symbol of success".

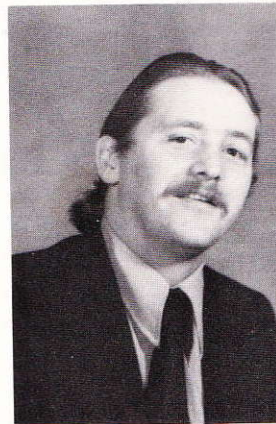
