(b) I have never been rejected for any of H.M. Forces on account of unfitness;  
(c) \*Having served in one of H.M. Forces, I now produce my Certificate of Discharge therefrom;
- That I am not in receipt of any pension or allowance from, or in respect of services in the Navy or the Army;
- That I have not already been rejected as ineligible for the Royal Naval Reserve;
- \*That I have not discontinued following my occupation at sea, and that it is my intention to follow the sea service for a period of at least five years from the present time.
